SPA Sports Day – Entry Procedure 2010

ENTRY FORM

The entry procedure for SPA UK Sports Day 2010 will be as follows:-

Every branch must submit their entry form by **Saturday 7th August 2010** to spausports@hotmail.co.uk.

SPORTS DRAW

The sports team will there after collate all entries and prepare for the sports draw.

The sports draw will be held on **Sunday 22nd August 2010, 1 – 3pm**, 2 Harp Place, Sandy Lane, Coventry, CV1 4DX.

Each branch must have the branch youth leader, the sports controller for the sport which the branch is controlling and a minimum of one branch executive present at the sports draw. This may be the branch president, secretary or treasurer.

At the sports draw we will also collect the branch entry fees and the deposits as per the Grievance procedure (40% deposit rule) please see below along with the branches entry fees:-

- *All Branches at the time of the Sports Draw will pay a 40% charge of their total Entry Fee value. This is a deposit that SPA UK will take as a measure of any Branches offending in any way. For example: Non – Prajapati that does not adhere to the 'associate member' guidance, is found playing in any sporting category, whether as part of a Team or Individual ... If the Branch has not offended and complied with the SPA UK procedure, the Branch will receive a refund 3 months after Sports Day has taken place.*

Definition of Associate Membership – An associate member under the SPA UK constitution states that “The Branch Association may at its sole discretion admit an individual as Associate Member with following rights, privileges and restrictions”:-

- (i) Any person whose application for individual (Life or Annual) membership cannot be accepted because the person is not a Prajapati by birth. Any such applications shall only be considered if the applicant qualifies to apply by virtue of marriage to a Prajapati or by adoption by a Prajapati Family.

- (ii) A person shall be admitted to the Associate Membership if he/she agrees with the aims and objects of the Branch Association and in doing so a signed declaration to that effect must accompany any membership application including renewal. Declaration must also include a statement from the applicant giving information of other such / similar organisation of which he/she is a member.
- (iii) For the purpose of this paragraph Prajapati is defined as “a community of people belonging to Hindu faith who originated from districts of Surat, Navsari and Valsad in the state of Gujarat, India whose ancestral occupation was mainly carpentry, pottery and masonry

We would need evidence from the branch that the person is a paid member if the participant is over 18, or his/ her parent/ parents is/are paid up members if the participant is under 18.

Participation tickets and spectator tickets will be handed out at the sports draw along with venue details and rules.

TEAM SPORTS ENTRY PROCEDURE

The SPA UK sports team has decided that we will take individual names of team players participating in team sports on the morning of sports day itself. This only applies to team sports – Football (all categories), Volleyball, Netball and Cricket.

The names of each individual must be handed in on the official *SPA UK Team Entry Forms 2010*. The individuals must be verified as ‘prajapati’s’ or an ‘associate’ member of the branch they are representing by either the branch president, secretary or treasurer and the team entry form must be signed by one of the 3 branch executives along with the team captains signature.

40% rule applies if team entry forms are not received on the day as implications for fire register and health and safety as well as us being able to communicate with sports controllers.

In order to maintain a flexible approach for team entries we have introduced the Team Entry Forms. For the branch sports entry forms you will need to enter ‘player 1, player 2 etc’ and pay for a full team for the team categories. If only 5 people participate in a team, we will reimburse the other players when we reimburse your 40% deposit fee.

Once again this only applies to the team sports.

CHANGE OF NAME DEADLINE

No later than the Thursday night of the week of the sports day for all other sports. For sports day 2010 the date will be Thursday 9th September 2010.

COMPLAINTS

The SPA UK sports team will deal with all complaints in writing via the email box spauksports@hotmail.co.uk. We will only deal with complaints that are received up to 2 months after sports day. The deadline for complaints is **Sunday 14th November 2010**.
